

INFORMATION NOTICE pursuant to Article 13 Regulation (EU) 2016/679 (“GDPR”)

1. DATA CONTROLLER AND DATA PROTECTION OFFICER

Dätwyler Holding Inc. with registered office in Gotthardstrasse 31, 6460 Altdorf, Switzerland, is the Data Controller of your personal data (“**Data Controller**”). You may contact the Data Controller at info@datwyler.com or via express courier at the address Gotthardstrasse 31, 6460 Altdorf, Switzerland.

2. PERSONAL DATA DEFINITION AND INFORMATION REGARDING THE PROCESSING ACTIVITIES

Under the GDPR personal data is defined as: “*Any information relating to an identified or identifiable natural person; an identifiable natural person is one who can be identified, directly or indirectly, in particular by reference to an identifier such as a name, an identification number, location data, an online identifier or to one or more factors specific to the physical, physiological, genetic, mental, economic, cultural or social identity of that natural person*” (“**Data**”).

The **Data Controller** process the Data you have provided, in order to send you press release e-mails.

In any event, we are committed to ensuring that the information we collect and use is appropriate for this purpose, and does not constitute an invasion of your privacy.

In case of failure to obtain your Data:

3. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR DATA TO EU AND NON-EU DATA PROCESSORS

In order to fulfil the purposes mentioned in paragraph 2 above the **Data Controller** may have the necessity to disclose your personal data to third parties, included in the following categories:

1. Third parties providing IT Services for Information Systems of the data controller and the IT infrastructure.

The above mentioned third party may act as *data processor* appointed by the **Data Controller**. Finally, in order to reach the purposes described under previous paragraph 2, your **Data**, may be processed by Data Controller's employees that have been specifically authorised to that aim. In addition, your Data might be disclosed to third parties, should such disclosure be required by the laws and/or Public Authorities.

4. YOUR RIGHTS AS DATA SUBJECT

At any point while we are in possession of or processing your Data and, if the case, your Sensitive Data, you, the data subject, have the following rights:

- Right of access – you have the right to request a copy of the information that we hold about you;
- Right of rectification – you have a right to correct data that we hold about you that is inaccurate or incomplete;
- Right to erasure – in certain circumstances you can ask for the data we hold about you to be erased from our records;
- Right to restriction on processing – where certain conditions apply to have a right to restrict the processing;
- Right of portability – you have the right to have the data we hold about you transferred to another organisation;
- Right to object – you have the right to object to the processing;
- Right to lodge a complaint: in the event that **Data Controller** refuses your request under rights of access, we will provide you with a reason as to why. You have the right to complain as outlined in paragraph 5 below.

5. COMPLAINTS
